NOHS FLAG LINE EXPECTATIONS AND ATTENDANCE POLICY

The NOHS Flag Line is a part of the North Oconee High School Titan Regiment. As an auditioned group within the NOHS Titan Regiment, members of the NOHS Flag Line are held to high standards. Below are the expectations specific to the NOHS Flag Line. These expectations are in addition to the rules and regulations outlined in the NOHS Band Handbook.

NOHS Flag Line Expectations

As a member of the NOHS Flag Line, you are expected to abide by the following.

- Maintain a positive attitude at all Flag Line events.
- Maintain a good rapport with the instructors, band director, student officers, parent volunteers, and other team and band members.
- Follow the rules and standards as outlined in the NOHS Band Handbook at all times.
- Follow the rules and standards as outlined in the NOHS Student Handbook at all times.

Poor conduct/behavior under any circumstance may result in warnings, loss of 3rd quarter breaks at football games, being benched for a performance or performances, suspension, or removal from the group. Inappropriate behaviors not only reflect on the individual, but can also affect the image of the entire team.

NOHS Flag Line Attendance Policy

All members are required to be present, on time, and dressed appropriately for all practices and performances. Comfortable clothes and tennis shoes should be worn to all practices, and the issued uniform should be worn to all performances. It is important to remember that one person's absence affects the whole team. If your performance ability is hindered due to absences, you will not be eligible to perform. Unexcused absences or tardies may result in loss of 3rd quarter break, benching, suspension, or removal from the group. A team member who is absent from the last practice before a performance may not be eligible to perform regardless of the reason for the absence. All absences must be communicated (via email or written note from a parent) to the band director ahead of time. Excused absences include illness, family emergencies, and religious holidays. Please note that summer camp is required for participation. The practice schedule is listed on the back of this page.

NOHS FLAGLINE FEES

- → \$450 Membership Fee (this includes uniform, shoes, gloves, performance equipment, camp fees, and competition fees)
- → \$250 team apparel and equipment fee New Members Only (this includes a warm up jacket and pants, a team backpack, a practice flag, and pom poms)

These fees can be paid in 2 installments:

- ★ Non Refundable payment due May 17th (last day of school)
 - \$250 for returning members
 - \$300 for new members
- ★ Remaining balance due July 16th (first day of summer camp)
 - \$200 for returning members
 - \$400 for new members

NOHS FLAG LINE SPRING AND SUMMER PRACTICE SCHEDULE

If you are selected to be a member of the group, you will need to have a physical on file with the school by May 17th. A physical is not required for try-outs.
